

## **Henley Masters Regatta 2021 COVID-19 Statement**

By entering a crew in Henley Masters Regatta 2021, you are agreeing to the following:

I am entering this crew and am ticking the box below on behalf of the crew confirming that I have obtained their consent on all of the items below. I will also act as the NHS Track & Trace coordinator for this crew.

HMR is taking place during the COVID-19 pandemic. HMR wishes to ensure that we keep possible transmission to a minimum and abide by all current restrictions while permitting safe and enjoyable racing. HMR encourages competitors to take lateral flow tests to exclude COVID in the days leading up to the regatta.

I/We agree to abide by the general government restrictions and advice as provided by HMR, in particular maintaining social distancing and adopting additional hygiene procedures.

I/We agree that in the event of even a mild illness until COVID is excluded by the absence of symptoms or a negative test you will not attend the regatta.

If visiting from another country:

You must follow the rules in place for travel between the relevant countries, this is changing on a rapid basis, so it is your responsibility to check the current rules and follow them. HMR may well ask you to provide travel plans and evidence that you are planning your trip with full compliance in mind and test results if available. If it becomes apparent that quarantine or self-isolation has not or could not have taken place you and your entire crew will be barred from the Regatta and there will be no refund of fees paid.
